

## Back to School Supply List for Grades 6, 7, 8 - Middle School

**Note: It is cheaper to buy supplies NOW they are on sale!!!!**

- ❖ NIV Bible
- ❖ 1 combination padlock – *all combinations must be given to the office on the first day of school, so don't open the padlock until you get here – the numbers may be lost!!!!*
- ❖ 2 packages of index cards
- ❖ "F" drive (also known as a "flash drive" or a "zip drive")
- ❖ Dictionary
- ❖ Three 3 ring binders (1 to 1 1/2" binders)
- ❖ 5 packages of loose leaf notebook paper (wide rule)
- ❖ 1 packages of subject dividers (1 dozen per pack)
- ❖ Markers ~ thin / or colored pencils
- ❖ Crayons
- ❖ 3 glue sticks
- ❖ 2 packages of *sharpened* pencils
- ❖ 1 large eraser
- ❖ 1 pencil pouch (with 3 holes to fit into binder)
- ❖ 1 package of pens
- ❖ Highlighter
- ❖ White out
- ❖ 5 pocket folders ~ plastic ones hold up best
- ❖ 6 black & white composition books
- ❖ Calculator
- ❖ Protractor
- ❖ 1 ruler with metric measure
- ❖ 1 box of soft tissues
- ❖ 1 bottle of antibacterial hand gel (6<sup>th</sup> grade only)
- ❖ 1 pack of antibacterial hand wipes (7<sup>th</sup> grade only)
- ❖ 5 large book covers

*Additional items may be necessary throughout the year.  
Assignment books will be purchased by the school for each student.*

**A Note About Lockers:** *If the student plans on decorating the inside of his/her locker, only themes and artists that are appropriate may be used. Students are expected to keep lockers organized and are responsible for them. Periodic locker checks will occur during the school year. Cell phones, if a parent feels that the student needs to bring them to school, must be dropped off in the office each morning. The student is responsible for picking up the phone & signing it out in the afternoon before leaving. All other electronics (game systems, music players, etc) should be left at home (not in locker)*
